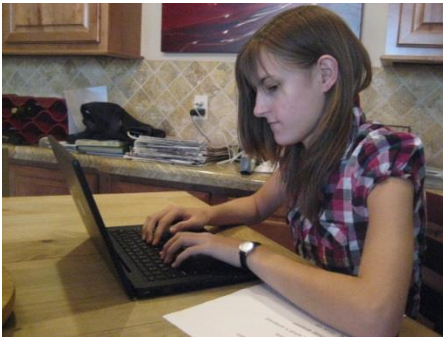


PARTICIPATE IN A RESEARCH STUDY ABOUT WRITING!
